




For our last story time of the year, we'll read *Maisy's Snowy Christmas Eve* by and decorate our own Christmas cookies with frosting and sprinkles!



#### Tues., Sept. 26 at 5:30 PM and Fri., Sept. 29 at 10:30 AM




Woah, it's fall already! We'll learn about the seasons reading *The Busy Little Squirrel* and make a cute little curlytailed squirrel craft.


